*The first wine of the Estate, predominantly Cabernet Sauvignon. Dark ruby with excellent perfume of pain grille, spice box, red and blackcurrants. Supple wine with light, elegant tannins. Ripe flavours with well integrated oak, tannin and acidity.*

**Boroli Barolo 2004 List €95.00 For You €55.00**

*Boroli makes his wines in an accessible style but without losing any of the power of this amazing terroir in Piedmont. Made with 100% Nebbiolo grapes, this is a full-bodied wine with an amazing array of flavours – dark fruits, violets, liquorice and many others – make this a fascinating wine to drink and firm but ripe tannins make it a fantastic choice for red meat or cheese.*

**Degani Amarone 2008 List €75.00 For You €55.00**

*Degani Amarone, is a very full-bodied, rich, hedonistic wine with very intense dark cherry and chocolate flavours, massive concentration and intensity and a long and complex finish. A wine to savour.*

**Pommard 1er Cru 2005 Clos Micault, Joseph Voillot List €120.00 For You €80.00**

*This is a medium-bodied wine, light in colour, but with huge fruit concentration and minerality deriving from its very old vines in one of the best sites in Pommard. Very complex wine for a special occasion. Drinking really well.*

**Chateau de Fieuzal 2007, Pessac Leognan List €100.00 For You €65.00**

*Since being taken over by Lochlann Quinn, this property improves all the time and is one of the stars of Pessac Leognan.. Rich, full-bodied but elegant, it has masses of blackcurrant fruit and cedar, tobacco notes as well as spice and rich, ripe tannins. Beautiful wine for a good steak or to go with cheese.*

**Chateau Leoville Barton 2002, Saint Julien List €160.00 For You €95.00**

*Always one of the best and most fairly priced of the big names in Bordeaux, this 2<sup>nd</sup> Growth wine with strong Irish connections is full-bodied and smooth, with textbook notes of cigar box and cedar, combined with lush blackcurrant fruit and spice. Delicious wine and great value at this price.*

**Saint Aubin 1er Cru 2009, Domaine Colin Morey List €75.00 For You €55.00**

*From the single vineyard known as "Champlots", this is exemplary wine from one of the new star growers in Burgundy. Pierre-Yves is keen to keep freshness as well as power in his wines; this great Saint Aubin is a medium bodied white with great balance and concentration, well-judged oak aging and a long, long finish. Amazing stuff.*

**Meursault "Narvaux", Domaine Darviot Perrin List €95.00 For You €65.00**

*Narvaux is a well known lieu-dit within the village of Meursault, and this is a great example. Pure and fresh with great concentration, this is a full-bodied wine with terrific poise and balance. Excellent wine from an excellent producer and from an excellent vintage – you won't be disappointed!*
